Chairman Kier Dirlam called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. Introductions were made, and a sign-in sheet was circulated.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Bob Keis made a motion to accept the September 20, 2018 minutes as distributed. Chuck Couture seconded the motion and it carried.

Correspondence

There was no correspondence.

Project Review Report

There were no project review reports.

Executive Director's Report

1. Comprehensive Economic Development Document (CEDS)

The 2018 CEDS Document was distributed prior to the September Board Meeting and posted on the STW website for 30 days for review. A motion was needed for the Board to formally adopt the CEDS

as written and forward it to the Economic Development Administration. Bob Keis so moved, Donna Vickman seconded the motion and it carried.

2. Appalachian Regional Commission

Approved Presidentially, the FY2019 Energy and Water Appropriations Act includes \$165 million for ARC – the largest appropriation for ARC’s non-highway work in the agency’s history. The legislation includes \$73 million for ARC’s base program; \$50 million for the POWER Program of special assistance to coal-impacted communities; \$16 million for a program of workforce and industrial site development focused primarily on the automotive and aviation sectors in South and South Central Appalachia; \$16 million for a program of basic infrastructure improvements in distressed counties in Central Appalachia; and \$10 million to continue a program of broadband deployment in distressed counties in Central Appalachia.

Board approval was needed for STW to submit a funding application to ARC in the amount of \$300,000 (the amount requested for the past 3 years). Norm Marsh so moved, Jay Gould seconded the motion and it carried.

3. State Archives and Records Administration

Staff sent an e-mail to gauge interest in a records management grant for 2019. Currently, 40 local governments have responded affirmative. The grant will request shelving units, scanners, potential Laserfische needs, and electronic conversion of minutes, vital statistics, payroll records, and cemetery records. A motion was needed to apply to NYS Archives for a grant in the range of \$20,000 - \$40,000 for funding. Bob Keis so moved, Chuck Couture seconded the motion and it carried.

4. EDA Funding

Board approval was needed to apply to EDA for a grant in the amount of \$70,000 for funding (the amount requested for the past 5 years). Craig Clark so moved, Norm Marsh seconded the motion and it carried.

5. NYS DEC Baseline

Board approval was needed to apply to NYSDEC for a grant in the range of \$33,000 - \$38,000 for funding per year for water quality management planning activities, including tasks to determine the nature, extent and causes of point and non-point source water pollution problems, and to develop plans to resolve these problems. Jay Gould so moved, Chuck Couture seconded the motion and it carried.

6. Angel Fund

Steve Mercil, STW Contractor, will meet with perspective investors on October 31st and November 1st. The meetings will be held throughout our three counties. A motion was needed for Southern Tier West to create a savings account for the short term, having Bob Keis and Richard Zink as signers on the account to collect funds from participating entities. Jay Gould so moved, Craig Clark seconded the motion and it carried.
