



What is RMC?

- The Registered Municipal Clerk
 Designation is a title awarded by the
 State Association (NYSTCA)
- Program to recognize educational and professional accomplishments
- Serves to promote the continued education of Municipal Clerks
- Enhance Performance and Status of Clerk

- Promote the Image of the Clerks
 Profession
- Enable Clerks to Make their Skills more Marketable
- Ensure the Public that RMC's are required to possess at least a minimal level of competence

Requirements and Qualifications

First time and Renewing Applications are Valid for Five Years

First Time Applicant

- Education 50 points
- Experience- 50 points
- Member of NYSTCA (3 yr. minimum)
- Town Clerk or Deputy Town Clerk
- Affirm the NYSTCA Code of Ethics
- \$75.00 Application Fee

Renewing RMC Designation

- Education- 20 Points
- Experience- 20 Points
- Member of NYSTCA
- Town Clerk or Deputy Town Clerk
- Affirm the NYSTCA Code of Ethics
- \$30.00 Application Fee

RMC Education and Experience

Education Points (50 for New Application/20 Renewing)

Examples of <u>Educational</u> Points

- Attendance at a NYSTCA Conference
- Professional Development Courses
- Attendance at NYSTCA Regional Meetings
- NYS Archives Workshops
- Notary
- College Degree (s)
- County Association Meeting/Training

Education Points (50 for New Application/20 Renewing)

Examples of Experience Points

- Municipal Clerk- Full or Part time
- Deputy Municipal Clerk- Full or Part Time
- Administrative Position in Local Government
- NYSTCA Association Officer, District Director, Committee Chair
- County Association Officer
- Position in Related Professional Association (ex: water/sewer billing Clerk, Tax Collector)

Designation Requirements

CMC

- Full, Additional Full, or Retired Member of IIMCminimum two year requirement
- Affirm the IIMC Code of Ethics
- 60 Points Education (1 point per two hour IIMC Approved class)
- 60 Points Experience
- CMC Admission Application Form (enrollment into the CMC Program)
- CMC Application for CMC Designation (Point Request Form) and Supporting Documentation
- Employment Verification Letter




